

RULES

GENERAL

1. **ENTRIES MUST NOT HAVE COMPETED AT THE PREVIOUS WOODSTOCK WOOD SHOW.**
2. The use of kits and/or duplicators is not permitted in the creation of work.
3. Each competitor may enter a maximum of TWO ENTRIES per category with the registration fee of \$20.00
4. ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 for any number of categories. Youth registration fee is \$10.00
5. Entries are subject to recategorization at the discretion of the judges.
6. Insurance protection is the responsibility of the competitor.
7. Entry fee includes admission to the show.
8. Please identify your entry by title or description.
9. Carving and woodworking entries will be awarded prizes at the discretion of the judges.

RULES FOR WOODCARVING

1. Limited use of non-wood materials will be allowed on wood carvings. ie. metal feet, glass eyes
2. Natural Finish - both texture and grain of the wood must show through the finish. Limited staining and/or woodburning permitted. Painted finish - an opaque finish that obliterates the grain of the wood.

RULES FOR WOODWORKING

1. Furniture means moveable articles such as tables, chairs, desks, etc.
2. The term "marquetry" is inlaid work consisting of fine woods for decorative effect on furniture and other articles.
3. Limited use of non-wood materials will be allowed on entries. Plastic veneer will not be permitted.
4. The term "intarsia" is a surface decoration made by inlaying small pieces of wood in patterns; mosaic woodwork.

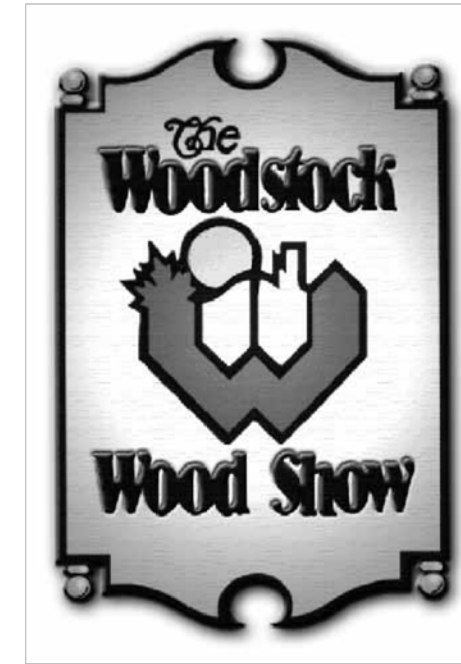

Open	One who carves or does woodworking and sells his/her work to earn a living and/or has won a Best in Show Amateur.
Amateur	One who carves or does woodworking for his/her own enjoyment, and does not sell his/her work to earn a living and/or has not won a Best in Show in a competition.
Novice	A beginner.
Youth	16 years of age and under
In Relief	Means carving executed in manner to decorate a generally flat surface to give the illusion of depth.
In the Round Open	Means shaping of a free-standing three dimensional form.
